- ◇ HGV toolkit—Chris Pearson: What we are concerned with are vehicles over 7.5 tonne weight limit. NYCC to enforce the limits. We're looking at how to get the knowledge back to them so they have data to work on. Signage needs to be looked at also.
- ◇ Fly Tipping—Howard Ferguson's report. Comments back. Costs for publicity to be from our project budget. Suggestions required on the appropriate format to publish it.
- ◇ Transport—Jack Crawford—talked to Arriva and Utopia. On the agenda for next meeting. Have a transport night. Invite Northern Rail also.

Funding decisions and agreements

The Partnership Board approved the recommendations from the Funding Group as follows:

Selby District Vision—£946.00 approved

Monk Fryston—Olympics: £1,500—they funding group would like to see more money spent on activities in schools. Posters, photo competitions. More detailed information. Margaret Johnson advised that most of the banners and posters and publishing will be done by the schools involving the children.

Scouts—St George's Day Parade: We believe the scouts and guides do get involved from the area. The funding group would like a proper application submitting.

Olympics: we are expected to put on a good show by the Olympic committee. Monk Fryston have contacted every school and Parish Council and had open days, done leaflet drops. We are encouraging other villages. The Chair said the CEF needs to be involved in it.

We have asked most of the schools. There is Health & Safety issues. 300 children were taken out to see how much room they take up. They have emailed every school in the district and they may give them a day off school. It will be managed. John Mackman said there is the agreement within the CEF Steering group that funding for the Olympics could go higher than £1,000. The Chair agreed.
